### **Principal's News**

Welcome back to the 2018 school year and a special welcome to all the new students and their families. As many people are aware Mrs Foley has moved to Alstonville Public School for this year. My name is Phil Cavanagh and I will be relieving Principal for 2018. I look forward to working with the students, staff and community throughout the year. My previous school was Gillwinga Public School in South Grafton. I have spent a lot of time in Yamba over the years and still have strong family connections to the town. I was a member of the surf club for over twenty years and enjoyed many weekends sailing, sailboarding, fishing and surfing in the local area.

This week students will be placed in classes but please be aware that there may be some changes depending on the final number of Kindergarten enrolments which will determine the make-up of the classes particularly in the Infants (K-1-2) area, please bear with us as we work through this process.

Book packs are now being distributed to students in the classroom. It would be appreciated if you could make payment as soon as possible for your child's book pack via the office or online through our school website. To assist those families with multiple children we have discounted the cost of the book packs. For a single child the cost is \$60, for two children \$110, three or more children \$150.

The annual school swimming carnival is set down for Friday 16<sup>th</sup> February. All students from 3-6 will be attending the carnival. Those students in year 2 who are turning 8 in 2018 will also be eligible to compete. A note will be coming home shortly providing more information.

At our first assembly on Tuesday morning Mr. Clifford outlined the changes for those students participating in Northern Rivers and North Coast Sporting events. The main area of change will be in regard to the collection of levies. Any student who attends a Northern Rivers or North Coast carnival will need to pay the money directly to Mr. Clifford. It is also important to remember that those students attending trials need to have a signed permission note. Mr Clifford will outline these changes in more detail to help ensure that everyone is aware of what is required.

Very shortly we will say farewell to Mrs Lange who will teach her very last class on Friday this week. We are also saying farewell to Mrs Reeves who has worked in the office for numerous years and provided support to students, parents and at Yamba Public School. On behalf of the school community I would like to thank both these staff members for the work they have done at Yamba Public School and wish them all the very best for the future.

Once again welcome to the 2018 school and I look forward to working with the whole school community for the benefit of all the children at Yamba Public School.
