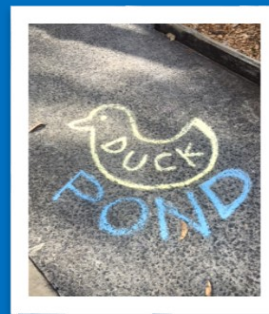
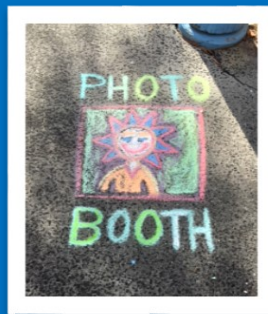
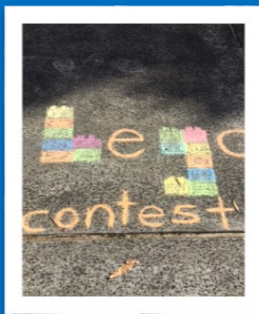

New exhibition uncovers Australia's fascinating shipwreck history

SUBMERGED – STORIES OF AUSTRALIA'S SHIPWRECKS

1st December 2018 to 31 January 2019 at The Old Kirk, Yamba Museum, River Street, Yamba.

Australia's coast is the final resting place of over 11,000 shipwrecks –14 of these wrecks will feature in a nationally touring panel exhibition ***Submerged – Stories of Australia's Shipwrecks*** uncovering Australia's rich shipwreck history, which comes to Yamba in December.

Submerged is presented by the Australian National Maritime Museum and the Australian Maritime Museums Council and is the result of a national project with workshops held across the country to develop the exhibition and to source shipwreck stories.

The exhibition features wrecks of merchant vessels, trawlers, schooners, whalers and a submarine. The oldest wreck featured is WA's *Batavia* while other wrecks include: *Sanyo Maru*, a Japanese motor vessel lost in 1937 in Boucaut Bay NT, British merchant ship *Sydney Cove* lost in 1797 off Preservation Island, Tasmania and the Fijian fishing trawler *Degei* which struck rocks on Donington Reef, SA in 1974. One shipwreck is from outside Australia – Australia's second submarine HMAS *AE2*, which was lost in 1915 during the First World War in the Sea of Marmara, Turkey.

This exhibition will be supplemented by displays on local shipwrecks closer to Yamba.

An Education kit for this national touring exhibition is available from Sue Spence, Education Officer, at the Yamba Museum. All 68 submitted shipwreck stories are available now on the AMMC website: www.maritimemuseumsaustralia.com/page/submissions-1.

A nominal museum entry charge of \$2 per student applies, with free admission for accompanying adults.
