Principal's Report

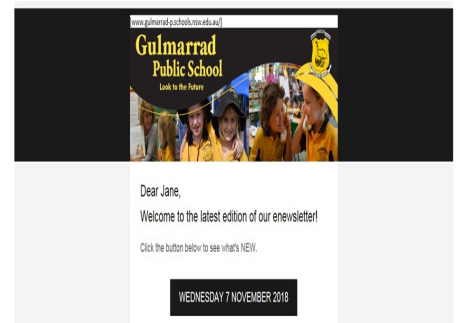
Welcome to Week 5 of Term 4

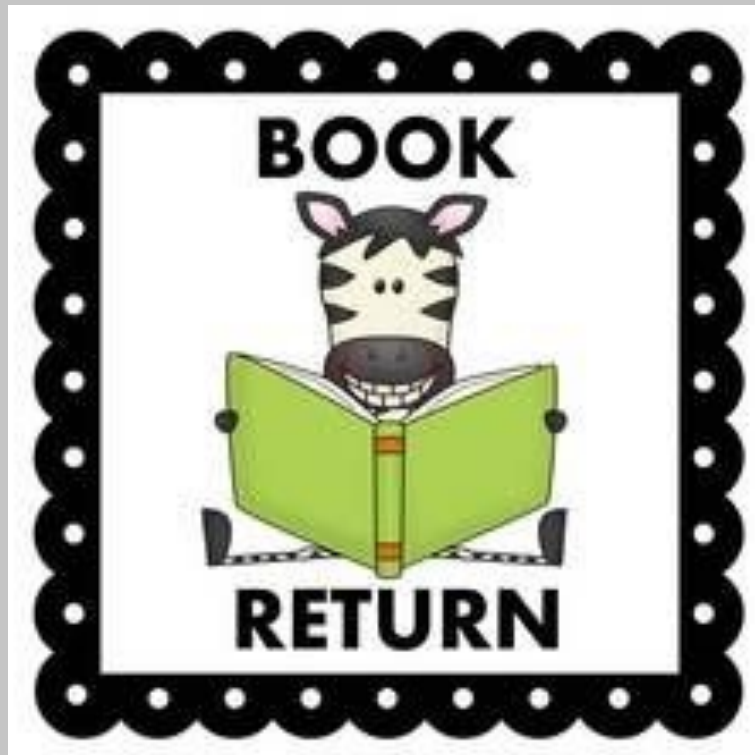
